Television Channel Use

The local cable educational channel, commonly referred to as Channel 26, enables communication directly to resident cable customers of the cities of Shoreline and Lake Forest Park throughout the day, seven (7) days a week, 24 hours a day, with both alphanumeric (text) and video information. The general purpose of the channel is to distribute information concerning district and school activities/services.

The Shoreline School District, in collaboration with the City of Shoreline, coordinates the gathering, formatting, and programming of information from throughout the school district for telecast on the local Cable Television Channel.

The district's contributions to Channel 26 are for the purpose of distributing information concerning district and school activities and services. Contributions shall be authorized by the Office of Community Relations, shall be consistent with the Public Information Program, and coordinated through the Office of Community Relations.
