Transportation Department – Winter Weather Information

On the reverse side of this sheet are the **2009-2010 REVISED** “*Snow Routes*” established for Shoreline School District, and more specifically for your child’s school. If you hear the announcement “Buses operating on snow routes”, the stops listed on the *Snow Route* listing are the only stops that each route will serve.

Snow Routes are established largely based on information provided by the cities of Shoreline, and Lake Forest Park; which identify the specific streets that are “priority” streets for snow / ice removal and maintenance. The stops are located with the safety of all of the students and the bus in mind, therefore your child’s *Snow Route* stop may be further away from your home than the regular bus stop. We appreciate your cooperation!

Please remember the following:

- Because of routing issues, the *Snow Route* stop closest to your home may be on a route other than the route your child normally rides. Please look at all of the stops on the routes serving your child’s school to determine the nearest stop.
- In snow / ice, buses will not stop while travelling on a hill (up or down). If your stop is on a hill, please go to the top or the bottom of the hill to catch the bus.
- In inclement weather, safety is our #1 priority, and buses will often be running late. Please be patient.
- For school schedule updates / reports, call the Shoreline Schools Report line at 206-361-4400, or check online at www.schoolreport.org or www.shorelineschools.org. Please **DO NOT** call the transportation office for school report updates.
- If your child rides a route numbered 200 or above, your *Snow Route* stop information will be provided to you directly from the driver.
- Regardless of conditions, if snow routes are utilized in the morning “to school”, snow routes will also be utilized in the afternoon “from school”.
