ACTFL Proficiency Level	STAMP and WorldSpeak Score	Possible Credits
Novice Low	1	0
Novice Mid	2	1
Novice High	3	2
Intermediate Low	4	3
Intermediate Mid	5	4
Intermediate High	6	4
Advanced Low	7	4
Advanced Mid	8	4
Advanced High	9	4
Superior	10	4
Distinguished	11	4
Native	12	4

How to calculate credits for **STAMP**

Use the **lowest** score of the skills tested to calculate credits since this represents the most consistent skill level.

For instance if a student scores on the STAMP:

- Reading 3
- Speaking 6
- Writing 5
- Listening 4 (optional)

Use the STAMP score of 3 to calculate the credits; in this case 2 credits.

How to calculate credits for **WorldSpeak**


Use the lowest score of the skills tested to calculate credits since this represents the most consistent skill level.

For instance if a student scores on the WorldSpeak:

- Speaking 3
- Writing 4

Use the WorldSpeak lowest score of 3 to calculate the credits; in this case 2 credits.

Native	5	12+	4

How to calculate credits for [ALTA](#)

Use the **lowest** score of the two skills to calculate credits since this represents the most consistent skill level.

For instance if a student scores on the [ALTA](#):

Speaking ILR 1+

Writing ILR 1

Use the ILR Rating of 1 to calculate the credits; in this case 3 credits.
