- When there is a certain brand of supply requested, please try to purchase that brand if possible. Certain brands work more effectively and produce higher quality student work.
- Teachers might request additional supplies throughout the school year.
- There will be a few additional supplies purchased by the 5<sup>th</sup> -6<sup>th</sup> graders during the first week of school.

## **Grade 1 Fall 2019**

### **Individual Items (please label with student's name)**

- 1 backpack or book bag (label with name)
- 1 zipper pencil bag
- 1 box crayons (24 colors maximum)
- 1 pair of Fiskars scissors
- 2 Pee Chee-type folder with inside bottom pockets
- 1 black/white Theme book, wide-lined (not College)
- 2 wide-lined spiral notebooks, single-subject size

(Please - no 3-ring binders, Trapper Keepers, or mechanical pencils)

### **Shared Items (do not label)**

- 1 box **Crayola** wide tip markers
- 1 box **Crayola** colored pencils
- 2 large pink erasers
- 12 large glue sticks (6 more in February)
- 12 #2 pencils (**Ticonderoga brand only**)
- 1 package of Stickers – any style appropriate for 1<sup>st</sup> grade)
- 2 full-sized box of facial tissues
- 1 pack/container of Lysol or Clorox sanitizing wipes  
or Baby Wipes
- 1 pump bottle of Liquid Soap
- 1 package of cheap napkins or paper plates
- 1 box zip-lock plastic bags (either gallon or sandwich size)

- Colored pencils
- 1 package thin tipped colored markers
- 1 composition book
- 2 black fine tip Sharpie pen – one in January also
- 5 - 8-1/2" x 11" spiral-bound notebooks **at least 70 pages each**
- 2 or more Red pens
- 2 highlighter pens
- 4 folders with brad fasteners and pockets
- 1 set of ear buds or small headphones

### **Shared Items (do not label)**
