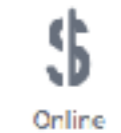
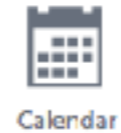

Welcome Back to Naviance

While there are annual assigned tasks in Naviance, the system will be of the most benefit to you if you put it to work for you. Every few weeks, log in and do some exploring.

January 2018 Naviance Tasks

Via English 10 Class visits to the Career Center, students are asked to do several tasks in Naviance and a worksheet. Collectively, these tasks are part of the state-required High School and Beyond Plan.

1. Complete "My Three Things Goal." (required)
2. Complete Cluster Finder. (required)
3. Add schools to your Colleges I'm Thinking About list under the Colleges tab. (recommended)
4. Do a SuperMatch, which you can find under the Colleges tab, and play with the variables. (recommended)
5. Start a resume using A Google Doc or the tool in Naviance under the About Me tab. (recommended)
6. Familiarize yourself with the Scholarship List under the Colleges tab. (recommended)

This portion of the presentation was a live walk through of Naviance, and the features available. The best way to learn the tool is to log-in and explore!

About Me Tab: Goals, Resumes, Favorite Colleges or Careers, Test Scores

My Planner Tab: Tasks and Goals (can be assigned through Career Center class visits)

Careers Tab: explore career clusters, favorite career clusters, cluster finder survey tool, interest profiler survey tool, job profiles (with applicable skills, training required, and earning potentials by state)

Colleges Tab: Colleges thinking about list, Colleges applying to list, College Search (and the detailed College Profile revealed), College Compare (GPA/test score admissions profiles), SuperMatch (detailed search tool by most any criteria), Scattergrams (scatter plot showing student as compared to other SW applicants who were admitted, waitlisted, and denied), scholarship matches and searches

- College Scorecard - U.S. Department of Education
 - Search tools, program descriptions, costs, financial aid and debt, earnings of graduates, student body demographics, typical admissions ranges
 - Data about financial aid, debt, and graduate earnings all averages - doesn't take into account individual information (like EFC calculators, or compare outcomes for students with significant financial need to those without - so the numbers may not reflect your situation at all)
