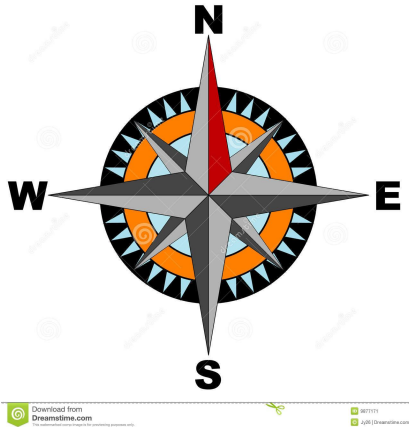
Purpose:

 - Identify top 2





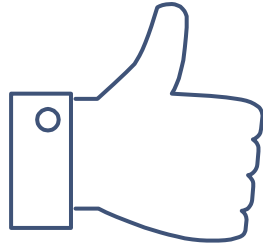
