This spring your student will participate in Smarter Balanced Assessments for state testing. **All students in grades 3-6 will participate throughout the district.** These assessments will be taken online during the school day and will assess the Common Core State Standards that our district and school use to inform instruction.

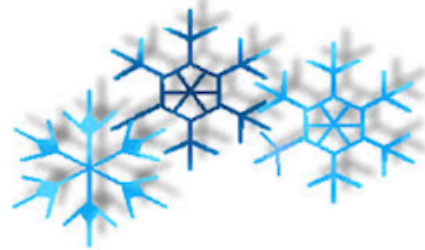

**SNOW MAKE-UP DAYS**

Due to the loss of instructional time caused by the snow closures in February, Shoreline Schools is adjusting the school calendar to meet the number of instructional hours required by the state.

- **June 3 will become a Full School Day.**  
This day had previously been a scheduled Staff Work Day.
- **June 14 will become a Full School Day.**  
This day had previously been a scheduled Half-Day Early Release.
- **June 17, 18, and 19 will be Full School Days.**
- **June 20 will be the anticipated Last Day of School with a Half Day Early Release.**

This plan allows us to meet our instructional time requirements and apply for one waiver day from the state.

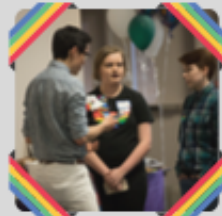
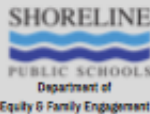

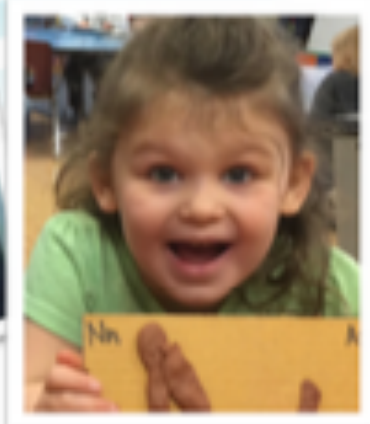
