

2014–15 Student School Supply List

Below is a list, by cluster, of school supplies your child needs. Teachers may request additional supplies throughout the school year.

Grades K/1

PLEASE DON'T LABEL THESE ITEMS! They are shared! Send to school in one of the paper grocery bags.

- 3 or more glue sticks
- 1 large package paper bowls
- 1 box of healthy storable snacks (crackers, granola bars, apple sauce, etc.)
- 2 pink pearl erasers
- Watercolor paint set
- 2 packs of water-based colored markers (1 thin point, 1 thick point)
- 24, #2 pencils (sharpened helps!)
- 3 pronged – 2 pocket folders: red, blue, and green
- 2 reams or more of white copy paper (8½" x 11")
- One container of hand sanitizer
- 1 large box of baby wipes or Clorox wipes
- Last name A-M: One box of facial tissues
- Last name N-Z: One box of large Ziplock bags
- 1 pair of kids scissors
- Set of 8-12 colored pencils (sharpened- we can't sharpen them in the school pencil sharpeners!)
- 1 box of 24 crayons

INSIDE THE BACKPACK SEND THESE LABELED ITEMS!

- Backpack (regular sized without wheels is best so it easily fits in a locker)
- Lunch box with items that kids can open without help (Hot lunch can also be purchased, just send a check made out to Shoreline School District)

Grades 2/3

Use permanent marker to clearly label the following:

- 1 large, roomy backpack (2 shoulder strap)
- 1 folder (bottom pockets)

Community supplies, do NOT label

- 1 box of **Crayola** wide markers, classic colors
- 1 box of **Crayola** thin markers, classic colors
- 1 box of **Crayola** crayons (box of 24)
- 1 box of **Crayola** colored pencils
- 2 large pink erasers
- 2 packs of **Ticonderoga** pencils, quantity of 12 – 24
- 1 small packet of eraser caps for pencils
- 4 large glue sticks
- 1 fine tip black **Sharpie**
- 1 super fine tip black **Sharpie**
- 2 packets of notebook paper (wide-rule)
- 2 composition books (wide-rule)
- 1 full size box of facial tissues
- 2 or more reams of white copy paper (8½" x 11")

Grades 4/5

Supplies do not need to be brand-new (i.e. backpacks, binders). Student planner provided.

Label the following items with permanent marker:

- 1 backpack or book bag (remember to label)
- 1 plastic school/pencil box and/or 1 zip pouch (remember to label)
- 1, 3-ring binder with 1" or 1.5" ring for personal organization
- 1 set of 5-tab dividers (if you are using a binder) – label in this particular order: Math, Language Arts, Writing, Science, Social Studies
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener for colored pencils (with attached container for shavings)
- 1 USB Drive (at least 2GB)
- 1, 3-ring binder (1 -1/2") & 2 pencils to be kept in instrument case (for band/orchestra)

Do NOT label the following, supplies are for class use and group projects:

- 1-box wide-tip color markers
- 1-box fine-tip color markers
- 1 box colored pencils (12-count)
- 5 packs of Ticonderoga pencils (qty of 12 to 24)
- 4 (solid) glue sticks
- 2 folders with pockets and brads (red, green)
- 1 full size box facial tissues
- 2 or more reams of white copy paper (8 ½" x 11)

Each family is asked to send in \$5 per student for use in buying certain supplies such as composition books, rulers, permanent markers, and more in bulk so that we can get them less expensively. Money can be turned in to the school office when it opens (August 11). Make checks out to Cascade K-8 Community School, with 4/5 supplies in the memo.

- 1 USB Drive (at least 2GB)
- 1 calculator (TI-30X are preferred) grades 7-8 only

Do **NOT** label the following, supplies are for class use and group projects:

- 1-box fine-tip color markers
- 2 highlighters
- 1 box colored pencils (12-count)
- 2 rolls of clear tape
- 5 packs of Ticonderoga pencils (qty of 12 to 24)
- 4 (solid) glue sticks
- 2 folders with pockets and brads (blue, yellow)
- 1 full size box facial tissues
- 2 or more reams of white copy paper (8 ½" x 11)
