

Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Shoreline School District No. 412 and Shoreline Children's Center Association

Implementation of Washington State's Paid Family & Medical Leave

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING regarding **Implementation of Washington State's Paid Family & Medical Leave** is effective as of January 1, 2019 and is supplemental to the 2018-2021 Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) between Shoreline Children's Center Association (SCCA) and Shoreline School District No. 412 (District).

WHEREAS, the State of Washington has approved a new statewide insurance program called "WA Paid Family & Medical Leave" to be administered through the State's Employment Security Department (ESD); and

WHEREAS, the new law requires the collection and payment of premiums by eligible employers beginning January 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the new law makes benefits available to eligible employees beginning January 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the new law applies to positions represented by Shoreline Children's Center Association;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties have agreed to the following:

1. The District will pay the employer premium designated in the law (.1467% of gross wages) beginning January 1, 2019.
2. The District will notify employees of the new law and collect the employee premium designated in the law (.2533% of gross wages) from employees represented by SCCA.
3. The District will remit the full premium (.4% of gross wages) to the Employment Security Department, as required by law.
4. Effective January 1, 2020, employees represented by SCCA will have access to the benefits described in the law.
