

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
Between
Shoreline Education Association and Shoreline School District

Joint Committee on Elementary Conferences

This Memorandum of Understanding, regarding Elementary Conferences, is between Shoreline Education Association (SEA) and Shoreline School District No. 412 (District) and is supplemental to the 2018-2021 Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) between the Parties.


WHEREAS, during negotiation of the CBA the Parties agreed to form a Joint Committee for the purpose of reviewing the structure of the elementary parent conferences described in Article 31.1 of the CBA;


NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree to the following regarding Elementary Conferences:

1. The District and SEA shall each appoint four (4) representatives to the Joint Committee.
2. The Committee shall be co-facilitated by one representative from SEA and one representative from the District.
3. The charge to the Committee shall be to:
 - a. research best practices related to elementary conferences; and
 - b. establish a schedule to support WAKids; and
 - c. develop a recommendation for consideration by the bargaining teams no later than December 15, 2018 for the elementary conference model to include in the 2019-2020 school year.




